

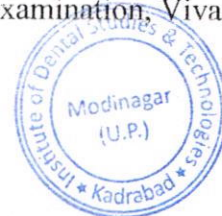

Academic calendar for MDS students (2022-25)

1. Syllabus/curriculum according to DCI and ABV University, Lucknow guidelines. All HODs to ensure that all their respective PGs should have a copy of the same.
2. Preclinical work to be completed by the end of 6 months
3. Selection of library dissertation/ main dissertation by 1st 6 months. Synopsis presentation for main dissertation on **17th February, 2023** (Synopsis submission- **1 week after Synopsis presentation**)
4. Mock basic Sciences exam (MDS part I) will be conducted by **2nd week of August, 2023**. Paper format will be according to new DCI guidelines
5. Submission of Library Dissertation by **31st August, 2023**.
6. **MDS part –I Basic Science Exam** will be conducted by ABV university at the end of first year
7. Second year annual exam to be conducted by respective departments i.e. **2nd week of November, 2024**. Paper formats will be as per New DCI guidelines
8. Submission of main dissertation six months before university exam(MDS part –II)
9. Mock Exam (MDS Part –II) will be conducted 2 months before University exams
10. Requirement for appearing in University exam
 - a. **Attendance**: every candidate shall secure 80% attendance (during each academic year)
 - b. **Progress and conduct**: every Candidate shall participate in the seminars, Journal review meetings, symposia, conferences, case presentations, clinic and didactic lectures during each year organized by the concerned department
 - c. **MIS report** - PG students will be submitting the same to, Director PG Studies on quarterly basis
 - d. Overall performance in 3 years (yearly exam + mock exam)
11. The university shall consist of Theory, Practical and Clinical examination, Viva voice and Pedagogy

Theory:

- a. *Part I* - shall consist of 1 paper on the basic sciences at the end of 1st year of course. The candidates shall have to secure a minimum of 50% in the basic sciences and shall have to pass Part – I examination at least 6 months prior to the final (Part-II) examination. There will be 10 questions of 10 marks each (Total 100 Marks) in this theory paper
- b. *Part –II* - (3 papers of 100 marks)
 - i. Paper – I : 2 long Essay questions of 25 marks each and 5 short Essays of 10 marks each
 - ii. Paper – II : 2 long Essay questions of 25 marks each and 5 short Essays of 10 marks each
 - iii. Paper – III : 2 out of 3 Essay Questions(50x2=100)

Practical and clinical examination: 200 Marks

Viva voice and pedagogy: 100 Marks

2. If the candidate discontinues the course in between due to any reason, he/she has to deposit full course fee
3. Annual fee to be deposited before the start of the new academic year.(yearly)
